## **4. Learning Outcome Approach**

Competence based approach is generally used as a main approach to vocational training and is reflected in the policy making and governing documents (like qualification standards). Learning outcomes are both explicitly and implicitly used throughout the process of nurse training. At the same time separate courses are a subject of internal control and development of training institutions and learning outcomes approach may be only partially reflected in taught subject descriptors and assessment methods.

## **5. Background Information on the Curriculum Formation and Application**

Curricula for training a “Junior specialist” in the field (speciality) 5.12010102 "Nursing" are developed by educational institutions according to the branch standard of higher education of Ukraine, field (speciality) 5.12010102 "Nursing", which was approved and put into effect by order No. 649 of the Ministry of education and science, youth and sports of Ukraine (June 24, 2011). The Standard is mandatory for higher education institutions that train specialists in the field.

The distribution of teaching hours in the elective component can be established by the educational institution according to a list of subjects in cycles. The normative part (6210 hours) envisages acquisition of competencies during the study of disciplines of humanitarian and socio-economic cycles (756 hours), natural sciences (918 hours) and professional (4536 hours) training.

The total number of hours of training practice in the vocational training cycle is 2830 hours and it is conducted under the guidance of a teacher. Of these, 1670 hours - educational practice in the corresponding classrooms and laboratories of the educational institution, and 1160 hours - independent work of the student in order to develop practical skills in the cycles of professional training under the supervision of a teacher.

Clinical practice totals of 432 hours and is distributed into the production (108 hours, 4th semester) and pre-diploma (324 hours, 6th semester) practices.

The study of all disciplines is completed by the summative assessment, usually in the form of exams or credits.

The distribution of hours for conducting consultations, examinations, and credits is carried out in accordance with the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated August 07, 2002 No. 450 "On the approval of time standards for planning and accounting of educational work and lists of the main types of methodological, scientific and organizational work of pedagogical and scientific - pedagogical workers of higher educational institutions".
